

## White Wine

175ml Bottle

1. **Semillon Chardonnay - Richmond Ridge - S.E. Australia** £3.60 £12.90

Fruity Dry White - Packed with ripe berry fruit flavours and complexity from the sunny Chardonnay grapes but given a clever dollop of lemony acidity from the Colombard to balance the sweeter fruit flavours. Soft and smooth in the finish with great length and freshness.

2. **Pinot Grigio - I.G.T. - dell'Umbria - Cantine Moretoni - Italy** £4.20 £14.50

Rich Dry White - Produced with Pinot Grigio from mid hill vineyards well exposed to the south east. This wine has the distinct soft, smokey characteristic of the grape variety. It provided a benchmark for fine wine in a region often overlooked for both its artistic and viticultural glories.

3. **Boschendal - Chenin Blanc - South Africa** £4.70 £14.90

Fruity Dry White - This fruity, well-balanced, medium-dry wine has a distinctive, exotic passion-fruit nose and appealing honey flavour on the palate. The ideal accompaniment for an al fresco summer lunch, lightly curried mussels, chicken and fish casseroles.

4. **Chardonnay/Semillon - Finca Las Paredes - Argentina** £15.50

Medium Dry White - Clear and bright, soft yellow with green nuances. The complexity produced by a soft amount of new oak and "sur lie" ageing results in hints of honey, butter, tropical fruit and vanilla, with added freshness from the Semillon. Soft in the mouth with a well-balanced, refreshing acidity and a lingering pleasant finish.

5. **Los Vascos - Sauvignon Blanc - Baron de Rothschild-Lafite - Chile** £16.90

Crisp Dry White - The color is limpid and brilliant with bright green highlights. The wine has the typical aromas of this particular grape variety which is characterized by boxwood leaves, accompanied by citrus and exotic fruit nuances. It is very fresh and juicy in the mouth with a pleasant harmony and good persistency. The Sauvignon Blanc made at Los Vascos comes from grapes purchased on long term contracts from both the Casablanca and Curicó areas. The vintages all share a very fresh and juicy in the mouth with a pleasant harmony.

6. **Briederner Ruberberger Domherrenberg - Riesling - Germany** £17.50

Slightly Sweet white - Fresh lemon and lime crispness with a very balanced sugar/acidity level, in a lovely blue bottle. At this price it is worth revisiting German wine. Great aperitif which won't get you too tipsy before the main event.

7. **Gewurztraminer - Vieilles Vignes - Alsace** £18.90

Medium Sweet White - This old vines Gewurztraminer virtually bursts out of the glass with fragrances of flowers, peaches and spice. On the palette it is ripe, rich and opulent with a fine texture and a long, fruity, spicy finish. It drinks well young, but will develop more complexity with some bottle age. Drink as an aperitif, with spicy Asian foods or with dessert.

8. **Chablis - Domaine des Marronniers - Burgundy** £19.90

Rich Dry White - Classic mineral and citrus fruit aromas are present on this elegant nose, the palate is restrained and poised with a racy fresh acidity, good lemony fruit and that classic minerality.

9. **Pouilly Fume - Domaine Cedrick Bardin - Loire** £20.50

Rich Dry White - This Pouilly-Fume comes from the best estate in the appellation. It is not like any of the other Pouilly-Fumes in that it has a very intense and powerful nose with fresh fruit and flowers and very complex overtones. The mouth is ample with a long crisp finish.

10. **Pouilly Fuisse AC - Chandesais - Burgundy** £23.90

Rich Dry White - Pouilly Fuisse wines owe their reputation to the high limestone content of the soils. This substantial wine has masses of style and elegance. This wine has emerald-gold tones which reflect a wine of finesse and distinction. The palate is harmonious, fresh and full of flavours such as toasted almonds, grapefruit and lemon. It can be drunk young but will develop a superb complex bouquet over 3-4 years ageing. Serve chilled with shellfish, fish, white meats in cream sauces and poultry dishes.

11. **Cloudy Bay - Chardonnay - New Zealand** £25.50

Fruity Dry White - The scent of pink grapefruit and lemon blossom is beautifully counterbalanced by smoky, savoury aromatics, reminiscent of roasted cashews and macadamia nuts. The palate is rich yet refined with a chalky texture supporting the delicious mineral-like complexity and creaminess derived from traditional winemaking techniques. Gentle fruit handling has produced a tightly structured, elegant wine that will age gracefully over the next six to ten years.

12. **Cloudy Bay - Te Koko - Sauvignon Blanc - New Zealand** £32.90

Aromatic Dry White - Pale straw green in colour and piercingly aromatic, the Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc shows all the characteristics of an excellent Marlborough season. An evocative fusion of fully ripened tropical fruits and freshly cut herbs layered over a base of fresh lime.

## Red Wine

15. **Terrazas Alto Malbec - Mendoza - Argentina** £3.60 £12.90

Medium-bodied Red - Bright red with slight violet hints. Intensely fruity with notes of plum and raisins blending harmoniously with aromas of vanilla and coconut. Taste: A medium-bodied, well-rounded soft wine. Flavours of cherry, morello cherry and red fruits dominate. The wine is young, easy to drink and displays a lively unison of fruit.

16. **Rothschild Mapa Merlot - Chile** £4.20 £14.50

Full-Bodied Red - Very intensive aroma of green pepper, spice and plum, with soft, rounded tannins and a full body.

17. **River Gum - Shiraz/Cabernet - S.E. Australia** £ 4.70 £ 14.90

Soft & Supple Red - This wine is a brick red colour with crimson hues and aromas of fragrant spice, forest berry and blackcurrant that combine with cedar, clove oak characters. The palate is vibrant and fresh with ripe plum, blackcurrant fruit flavours accompanied by spicy, vanilla oak, while the finish is quite long and soft.

18. **Pinotage - Welmoed Winery - South Africa** £15.90

Soft & Supple Red - A charming wine with a vivid ruby-red colour. Delicious round, raspberry and ripe fruit nose. Ripe mulberry fruit pallet elegant tannin finish and a soft fruit driven finish.

19. **Morgon AC - Beaujolais - Chandesais - Burgundy** £16.90

Light & Fruity Red - The Gamay grape produces a seductive full-flavoured, soft red with berry characteristics. Quite light in style but with tremendous juicy sweet fruit in the finish. Excellent chateau in one of the best hillside locations.

20. **Chianti "Raffaello" - Casa Vinicola Dreolino - Rufina - Italy** £17.90

Medium-Bodied Red - A wine of exceptional character, it is ruby-red in colour, tending towards garnet over time. The palate is well-orchestrated, fruity, soft and rounded, and displays excellent structure.

21. **Larchago - Crianza - Rioja Alavesa - Bodegas Larchago - Spain** £18.90

Medium-Bodied Red - Soft and appealing, offering clean raspberry and cherry flavours with a hint of spice. Nice balance and ample structure.

22. **Chateau Jamard Belcour - St. Emilion** £20.50

Full-Bodied Red - Fine amber-red with extremely pleasant touches of preserved fruit on the nose. Fruity, powerful and munchy, with a remarkable balance, the tannins blossoming smoothly and pleasantly in the aftertaste.

23. **Reserva - Marques de Murrieta - Rioja - Spain** £23.50

Full-Bodied Red - You won't find the intensity of these strawberry, cherries in any other wine from the region. The YGAY is good every year, and we hope this Bodegas will hold fast in their approach and resist elevating the oak influence, which we have noticed in recent Rioja vintages. Murrieta seems to wait about 6 years before releasing the Reserva and while the regular bottling is good, the Reserva is really worth the wait for its mature and more intense fruit. It's a complex and distinct bottle of wine with one of the most pleasant and unmistakable aromas anywhere. A beguiling wine from Espana. Intense wine with lengthy oak maturation and outstanding palate.

24. **Chateau Fleur de Jean Gue - Bordeaux** £25.50

Medium Bodied Red - A strong effort, the dense purple-colored & offers up sweet aromas of jammy kirsch liqueur intermixed with toffee, caramel, vanilla and spice. The wine is sweet, expansive. Jean du Gue Lalande de Pomerol, Bordeaux, France Bordeaux Blend. The wine is a blend of 75% Merlot, 20% Cabernet Franc, and 5% Cabernet Sauvignon. The lavishly oaked offers up gorgeous aromas of jammy black cherry and currant fruit along with hints of new saddle leather and toast. It possesses a plush texture as well as supple tannin. This hedonistic fruit bomb can be enjoyed during its first 5-7 years of life. (88-90) points. Robert Parker, Wine Advocate. Medium-bodied, with chewy tannins and a smoky finish, very impressive for a Lalande-de-Pomerol.

25. **Chateaufleur-du-Pape "Grand Cru" - Chemin des Papes - France** £28.90

Full-Bodied Red - Deep purple to the rim with a gloriously flamboyant nose of black raspberry jam, kirsch, smoke, and licorice, the wine has dazzling concentration, pushes ripeness to the limit but pulls back with impressive purity and balance as well as plenty of force and resistance. This is a supple, opulent style of Chateaufleur du Pape to drink over the next decade or more.

26. **Chassagne Montrachet - Bouchot Ludot - Burgundy** £32.90

Full-Bodied Red- It has a bright, cherry-red colour. The aromas are delicate and pleasantly rustic with sweet and bitter cherry and wild strawberry. Its body is full and fleshy with crispness and balance backed up by pleasant oakiness. It will be most enjoyed with red meat dishes, as well as with game fowl and mild cheeses.

## Sparkling Wine

Bottle

27. **Duc de Foix Cava Brut-Spain** £14.50

Bright, straw colour, fresh aromas of herbs and apples, full and long finish, fine and persistent mousse. Excellent as an aperitif, with white fish and any light courses.

28. **Decoree-Laurent Breban-Blanc de Blancs-Brut-France** £16.90

More like a wine with bubbles, this is concentrated and evokes minerals, apple and earth aromas and flavors. It's full bodied, muscular and has a fine texture and dried citrus aftertaste.

## Champagne

**29. Joseph Perrier - "Cuvee Royale" - Brut - France** **£29.90** **Bottle**

Few can resist the softness of the fruit flavours and the length on the palate of this Champagne, which is made by a small, family-owned Champagne house. Best served as an aperitif, it is also excellent with seafood and smoked salmon.

**30. Laurent Perrier - Brut - France** **£35.90** **Bottle**

The colour is a pale golden hue, with fine and persistent bubbles. The nose is fresh and delicate, showing good complexity with its hints of citrus and white fruit. With its elegant style, Brut L-P has led the way in making champagne the ideal apéritif. Perfectly balanced, with crisp flavours and finesse, it is also an ideal companion for fish, poultry and white meat. Delicate and fresh, with good complexity and notes of citrus and with fruit. Fresh and supple upon entry with rounded and expressive flavours from which the fruit progressively emerges. Good balance and length.

## Rose Champagne

**31. Laurent Perrier Cuvee Rose Brut N.V. - France** **£49.50** **Bottle**

This champagne is famous for its highly expressive bouquet, which stems from the very careful preservation of the grape's natural fresh red fruit aromas. It is one of the rare rosé champagnes to be made using the maceration technique, which gives it the extraordinary depth and freshness that has made it the benchmark for rosé champagne around the world. Revered by wine-lovers for its flavours and by aesthetes for the beauty of its 17th century-style bottle, the Cuvée Rosé Brut is one of the stars in the Laurent-Perrier range. Precise and very crisp with a lasting impression of freshness, it has hints of soft red fruits, such as strawberries, redcurrants, raspberries and black cherries. Intensely fruity flavours begin clean and well-defined upon entry, the wine then opens up to provide a melange of flavours consisting of fresh strawberries, raspberries and wild cherries. It has great length and is rounded and supple on the finish.

**32. Rose Reserve - Veuve Clicquot - France** **£56.90** **Bottle**

Veuve Clicquot is famous for its rosé champagne, the splendid result of both the winemaker's knowledge and expertise combined with the House tradition of wine-making which reaches back more than two hundred years. Although rosé champagne is considered the ideal wine for romantic occasions, it nevertheless delights connoisseurs and wine lovers alike. A pioneering House in the domain of rosé champagne, Veuve Clicquot was the first to commercialise it as early as September 1775. In keeping with tradition, Veuve Clicquot's Rosé Reserve is only made in the greatest years, and is a blend of white and red wine. The big-styled, surprisingly deep pink/copper-colored Rose Reserve displays a Pinot Noir-like perfume of pomegranate, bay leaf, earth, and spice. Bold, rich, expansive, and dense, it is an atypically, almost shockingly powerful, rich Champagne.

## Japanese Rice Wine

**33. Sawanotsuru Sake - Japan** **£5.00** **1/4 Bottle** **£18.00** **Bottle**

Produced in Japan from rice and water. Can be enjoyed warm or chilled.

## Rose Wine

**13. Blush Pinot Grigio - Tenuta Viscone - Venezia Giulia - Italy** **£4.70** **175ml** **£16.50** **Bottle**

Aromatic Dry - This has resulted in a rose coloured wine with copper reflections and a refined, intense bouquet with extremely pleasing hints of fruit. Slightly sparkling with a pleasing palate it is an enjoyable, harmonious wine.

**14. Tavel - Domaine Lafond - A.C. Tavel - Domaine bottled - France** **£19.90** **Bottle**

Crisp Dry - Tavel is a right bank appellation of the southern Rhone for dry rose wines only. The appellation enforces a maximum alcoholic strength of 13.5%. Chilling is essential; the wine is always bone dry although the Grenache and Cinsaut grapes give the impression of sweetness. The perfect accompaniment to Mediterranean dishes, Oriental cuisine, and fish.
